

BROOKTHORPE-WITH-WHADDON PARISH COUNCIL

PRECEPT JUSTIFICATION FOR FINANCIAL YEAR 2019/20

On 4th December 2018 the Council set a budget of £37,161 and a precept of £15,000. This is an increase of £9,695 on the precept for 2018/19. The remaining money of £22,161 will be paid from reserves.

£5,000 has been set aside for payment of the new Gateway Scheme and £3,000 towards the new Village Hall extension.

Other increases result from the need to increase the amount set aside for a Parish Newsletter, Village Enhancements and Community Events as well as inflation expenses.

The extra £9,695 will mean an increase of £8.39 per year for the average band D home in the parish. The Council feels that this is justified for the above projects to take place.
